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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

TEST DAYS – **Test day scheduling and level of tests will be determined by judges' availability.** Skaters should book their summer skating to include the test day at their level. In order to host test-days, regularly scheduled ice time has to be used. The summer school attempts to keep schedule disruptions to a minimum.

Test days will be held on the Thursdays and/or Fridays of Week 4 (July 27-28) and Week 8 (August 24-25) (up to and including Gold Freeskate, Skills, Dance)

Test days and times are dependant on judge availability.

TEST FEES WILL BE POSTED AT THE RINK AND MUST BE PAID ON-LINE BEFORE TESTS CAN BE TAKEN.

STROKING PROGRAM – This year Skate Saskatoon Summer School will provide a STROKING PROGRAM from Monday—Thursday (5:15—6:00 PM). This program will be geared for the **JUNIOR** and **INTERMEDIATE** skaters. It will emphasize stroking, speed, turns, field moves, edges, power, endurance, and general skating skills. Any **SENIOR** level skater will also benefit from this program taught by the Summer School Coaching Team. There will not be instruction on the Friday session (OPEN practice time).

Group times for skaters will be allotted according to freeskate levels as well as age and length of registered skating time at the School; the lowest level will start at JUNIOR and continue up to SENIOR. Dance music will be available for all levels. Freeskate sessions will have a limited number of skaters on the ice. Final group placement and requested changes will be at the discretion of Skate Saskatoon. Our goal is to group skaters so that everyone on is able to skate in a safe environment and to train as unrestricted as possible. The regular schedules are in effect for the August 7 holiday.

Grouping Guideline based on Freeskate and/or Competitive tests:

JUNIOR– Have not passed any Freeskate Tests or Passed Prelim FS, Junior Bronze FS; competing PreJuvenile at November 2017 Sectionals

INTERMEDIATE– Passed Senior Bronze FS, Junior Silver FS; Competing Juvenile at November 2017 Sectionals

SENIOR– Passed Junior Silver FS; Senior Silver FS; Gold FS; Competing Pre-Novice to Senior at November 2017 Sectionals

Junior MAX = 24 skaters; Intermediate MAX = 24 skaters; Open MAX = 24 skaters

Senior and Senior/Intermediate MAX = 18 skaters

SUMMER SCHOOL FEES

For early registration in the Skate Saskatoon Summer School, a skater must register with a Group Product on-line (1 per week) payment in full prior to scheduling. Priority Registration will be made for all Group registrations made on-line between March 15 and April 15, 2017

The skater's choice is to be indicated on the application form. Skaters may register for any number of weeks and may start on any Monday, which also must be indicated on the form. This would be considered your week # 1. **Appropriate times will be allotted to each skater based on registration time. Group programs may be registered in priority prior to April 15.** Late fees will be applied after June 1.

Summer registration for the entire season (9 weeks of Options) will open March 15

1. *FULL GROUP PROGRAM* - *THE MOST BENEFICIAL PROGRAM & BEST VALUE* - This entitles the skater to **one** skills/dance session, and **two** freeskate sessions per day for **Intermediate Skaters** during an appropriate group time, and **three** freeskate sessions per day for **Senior Skaters**.

Junior Group Program—includes one Freeskate; one skills/dance session per day (Monday through Friday)

Available **Summer Group Products** may be purchase on-line for Senior Group; Intermediate Group and Junior Group

2. EXTRA FREESKATE SESSIONS - Extra sessions are offered for all Skate Saskatoon members and registered summer school skaters. Skaters may register for any number of extra sessions chosen from those indicated in the skating schedule for the **entire Summer Season** or with Summer Ice Session Tickets. Regular Summer Season is available on-line at www.skatesaskatoon.com after April 15, 2017.

OPTION 1

(Summer School Weekly Intensive Program)

SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION

- Purchase Weekly Group Packages (Monday through Friday) – Weekly Products can be purchased on line (**EARLY BIRD SPECIALS APPLY UNTIL APRIL 15**)
- For early registration in the Skate Saskatoon Summer School, a skater must register by purchasing a Group Product on-line (1 per week for the appropriate level – Senior/Intermediate/Junior).
- Additional freeskate/dance/skills may be purchased per week (no carry over or make up sessions across weeks)
- Payment in full on-line by credit or debit is required prior to scheduling (no transfer to subsequent weeks) (**FORM A** with schedule requests and coaching assignments must be received prior to scheduling and prior to April 15th or the applicant will be placed in sessions by Skate Saskatoon administration).
- **Priority Registration** will be made for all Group registrations made on-line between March 15 and April 15, 2017 while **EARLY BIRD RATES APPLY**.

GROUP PROGRAMS

The following group times (indicated on the skating schedule) are scheduled with priority:

- Senior Group – includes **three** freeskate sessions per day (off-ice included if desired)
- Intermediate Group – includes **one** skills/dance session, **two** freeskate sessions per day and **one** off-ice session each day.
- Junior Group Program—includes **one** freeskate; **one** skills/dance session per day and **one** off-ice session each day.

Group Programming runs Monday through Friday (Stroking - Monday through Thursday).

FEE SCHEDULE—detailed fees are applicable per week per skater

Multiple Week Incentive – GIFT CERTIFICATES will be awarded based on purchase of 4 or more weeks of Program registration (\$100/4 week package) (\$200/8 week package). Gift

certificates will be applied to the family account and may be used for any family member and any subsequent registrations (Summer and Fall 2017).

Below is an estimation of fees (Final fees will be determined by On-Line Registration system) EARLY BIRD RATES stated below. All pricing will increase after April 15th.

- 1. INTERMEDIATE/SENIOR GROUP: \$110/week before April 15**
- 2. JUNIOR GROUP: \$90/week before April 15**

Skaters may register for any number of weeks and may start on any Monday. The skater's choice of registration options including the date of the each Monday (start day of the desired week(s) of registration. One week "Registration Product" is required for each week the skater wishes to attend.

NO MAKE UP SESSIONS OR CARRY OVER TO SUBSEQUENT WEEKS OR PARTIAL REGISTRATION WILL BE PERMITTED. Varied schedules may refer to Summer Ticket Ice Sessions/Daily Unlimited Skating Session Tickets or Seasonal registration packages.

Appropriate times will be allotted to each skater based on time of registration (Invoice Time of Payment). Group programs must be registered with Submission of a completed Form A (attached) prior to June 1 2017 (include Invoice Number). All Coaching requirements must be clearly indicated for scheduling.

REGULAR FEE RATES WILL BE APPLIED AFTER APRIL 15, 2017. LATE FEES May be applied or program registration will end when session are at capacity. Other forms of payment processed in the Skate Saskatoon office will be subject to an administration fee (\$25/payment).

NOTE: All Skate Saskatoon On-Ice rules apply. Weekly Intensive Registered Skaters receive priority for scheduling in regular sessions prior to April 15th. After April 15th, registration will be on a first come first serve basis. Ticket ice is subject to ice availability and will only be permitted if the session has available space and the skater is at the appropriate level. All Ice Usage is at the Discretion of the Club Manager and/or administration.
