Advanced CanSkate is Skate Saskatoon's "bridge" program between CanSkate and the StarSkate/Competitive Programs. It introduces skaters to the skills in edges, stroking, freeskate, turns, dance, and performance. The program reinforces daily, proper warm-up and practice technique. Confidence and ability to work independently at this level is another focus of this program. Skills will be monitored, and in the event that a skater is ready to take a Skate Canada test, they will be notified.

Advanced CanSkate participants must be able to confidently skate forwards and backwards, be able to stop under control, and be over 5 years old. ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE ADVANCED CANSKATE PROGRAM MUST WEAR FIGURE SKATES. It is recommended that skaters have or be working on (partly completed) CanSkate badge 3 before joining the Advanced CanSkate program. The Advanced groups are organized by age and ability. The placements are subject to change. Advancement from CanSkate to Advanced CanSkate must be approved by the Coordinator or Club Manager. Additional costs may apply.

In Advanced CanSkate—group lessons are offered 4 times per week—it is recommended that participants register for at least 2 sessions per week. The skater to coach ratio is approximately 7:1.

<u>ADVANCED CANSKATE PRACTICE and OPEN OPTIONS</u>—Extra open options may be purchased for a full season on-line. These extra options may be purchased outside of the group time. Maximum number of skaters allowed on open options is 24. Please indicate the best options for you.

DROP-IN OPTIONS—Options and Stroking Times may be purchased on a drop-in basis with Winter Ice Session Tickets. The skater must sign in the drop-in binder before skating. For options, please wait 5 minutes after the start of the session before going on the ice to ensure that the session is not full.

Missed Advanced Group time cannot be made up. Please see the Program Use Policy on the Website.

<u>SYNCHRO & STARSKATE/TEST COMPETITIVE</u> - If registered in any groups costing \$465 or more (for Beginner 1) or \$650.00 or more (for Beginner 2), skaters may join a Synchro team at a discounted rate. See Synchro registration form for details.

HOW TO REGISTER

- To Register you will need: email address, and a credit card
- If you are already a Skate Saskatoon member proceed to your shopping cart
- If you are not already a Skate Saskatoon member: Login to www.skatesaskatoon.com and create a member account
- Add members of your family who are wishing to skate as participants in your account
- Click on Shopping Cart in the top right corner of the website home page
- Select "Find a Program"
- Filter Your search by Entering "
 - o Winter 2016 as the season
 - Category (Star Skate and Competitive)
- Click register for the options you wish to skate and select a participant
- Your shopping cart should show 1 item, click on your shopping cart
- Continue by clicking on "Register for more programs" to register for more sessions! Or if you are finished, select "Confirm & Register"
- IF you have selected the wrong item and it has entered your shopping cart, click on the grey garbage bin next to the item to delete it from your cart.



- Enter your payment information and Pay on-line. Confirm your billing information and name on Credit card together with your skater's information which will be submitted to Skate Canada (if you are not previously registered with our Club).
- Your invoice will be emailed to your email address and is considered confirmation of registration.

PRIVATE LESSON REGISTRATION

- To register for private lessons, please select a coach of your choice
- Your coach will then be able to view your registered options
- Confirm with your Coach if there is available coaching time within your chosen schedule
- After entering your shopping cart and selecting "Find a program" search for the day or option number that you wish to skate on
- Click register
- Continue to Shop
- Additional Products include Lockers, Ice Session Tickets, Ice Show Tickets (coming soon!)
- Continue to check out
- Ensure you have selected the coaches for each skater on your participant profile that you will be seeking lessons. This serves as access from your coaches to your schedule. Arrange lesson times with your coach directly.
