Need Extra Sessions? Spring Ice Session Tickets are available on-line (Login: Click on your Shopping Cart/Purchase Products/Ice Session Tickets/Payment on-line). Your invoice will have "Print" to get your uniquely coded ticket enter the bar code in the "Sign in book" near the entrance to the ice surface. Only pre-paid skaters may skate. Any unpaid session will result in penalties and removal of ice privileges. All tickets expire at the end of June (Spring Season).

Ticket Usage: [All rules apply](#). Registered skaters receive priority on ice usage. Ticket users are required to only skate on sessions with available space and safe attendance. The Club Manager or coach will determine if a skater is safe on the ice at any time.

All Skaters must sign in! (podium near the Music Room)

PROFESSIONAL COACHES

Coaches: Our coaches are able to instruct students in private or semi-private lessons. As a registered member, if you wish to arrange for lessons, you select the coach you prefer to work with, then contact them using information provided below. If the skater is not enrolled in the Competitive Program with the designated times, arrangements must also be made with the office for ice time access. To arrange private lessons, one must contact coaches directly for lesson arrangements. Lessons are typically booked as 15 minutes.
