SPRING OPTIONS

1. **PRIVATE OR SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS** – Private and Semi Private lessons are available to all levels of skaters. These lessons are given on skating times organized by the coach and parent. Sign in rules under policies on the website provide the related information and must be adhered to in order to enter the ice surface.
