



Adult Figure Skating Program

Winter Term 1 2026 | October - December

A program that offers skaters with previous figure skating experience a session to revisit and progress their skills.

Program Details

- Includes 1 hour sessions weekly for 11 weeks.
- Past figure skating experience required, this is not a learn to skate program.
- This is an uninstructed program. It is coach supervised only.
- Private lessons for individual instruction during session time can be arranged separately for an additional rate.

Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1, 2026-August 30, 2027.
- Skaters must register only for sessions appropriate to their level.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account **"Participant Profile"** by selecting and viewing **"Calendar"** tab. Verification of all option dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
- Program fees do not include taxes where applicable.
- No pricing prorations.
