Program Information

- Ages 3+ CanSkate Stages 1–6.
- Independent (unparented) lessons. All #1-#8 CanSkate sessions are the same.
- Skate Canada NCCP- Certified Coaches and trained Program Assistants.
- Badge and ribbon progression.
- Must have a coach recommendation and coordinator approval to advance from CanSkate into Junior Prep. Figure skates are required in Junior Prep.

Required Equipment

- Gloves or mittens.
- Warm clothing skaters can move in.
- Rubber/plastic skate guards are required.

The session cost, program fees, and final session dates listed in the chart above already account for all scheduled rink closures.

Important Program Notes

- Parents/guardians or a designated supervising adult must remain at the facility during the session.
- Parents are not permitted in the ice area, off-ice room or music room unless authorized.
- Skaters who have not passed CanSkate Stage 3 must be registered in CanSkate group lessons and be in a lesson (private or group) whenever on the ice.
- There are no pricing prorations.

Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1, 2026-August 30, 2027.
- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account **“Participant Profile”** by selecting and viewing **“Calendar”** tab. Verification of all dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
