

On August 30 the City of Saskatoon passed a motion for masking requirements as per the below:

**Masks required in City-operated facilities & Saskatoon Transit effective September 1 2021**

*Effective September 1, to protect the health and safety of residents, customers and employees, masks are required when accessing indoor City-operated facilities and services and traveling on Saskatoon Transit. City-operated facilities include City Hall, Leisure Centres, indoor arenas, golf course buildings, indoor spaces at the Saskatoon Forestry Farm Park & Zoo and the downtown Saskatoon Transit Customer Service Centre. City Council approved the action at its meeting Monday, August 30 as an added safety measure to address the increasing spread of COVID-19 in our community.*

The City has confirmed this requirement is applicable throughout ACT including the ice surface. Skate Saskatoon has requested an on-ice exemption but **until further notice masks must be worn at all times when in ACT.**
