

FALL SCHOOL PROCEDURES for Skaters:

-arrive “skate ready”

-ALL SKATERS AND COACHES **MUST WEAR A MASK** INSIDE THE LOBBY. **No spectators are permitted.**

- 5-15 minutes before the skating session – skaters enter the arena, use hand sanitizer, and **stand** by one of the chairs in the order as you enter the building. **Only sit in the chair if you need to tighten skates.**

-**READ the Covid-19 screening questions posted throughout the building.** A Skate Saskatoon coach will ask you if you have answered NO to all of these questions, if you are unfamiliar with the questions, the Skate Saskatoon Coach will give them to you verbally. If your skater will need to answer YES to any of them, they will not be permitted to skate, and should not come to the rink until they can answer NO to all of the questions.

-skaters will enter the ice area while maintaining proper distancing indicated by the makers/tape on the floor. No bins will be used in fall. Skaters can remove their mask once they are on the ice surface and put it in a pocket of their clothing for the duration of the session. Skaters are permitted to place their belongings on the ground next to the pylon at the far end of the rink during their skating sessions.

-at the end of skating, skaters will **put their masks back on** and exit past the washrooms and out of the exit door (following the arrows on the ground). Skaters must use the hand sanitizer provided while exiting the skating area.

-skaters MUST continue to adhere to distancing guidelines on and off the ice (6 feet) at ALL times during the lessons or during individual practice.

****ONLY COACHES ARE PERMITTED TO OPERATE THE MUSIC SYSTEM****

****Club executive and coaches have the authority to ask skaters, members, volunteers, coaches, administrative personnel, etc. to leave if they are not following the above outlined protocols. Repeat incidents could result in suspension of privileges****
