

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADULT SKATING GROUP

SATURDAY, 6:15 – 7 PM

- 1. Arrive at the arena 10-15 minutes before the start of the session.**
- 2. Use the main doors. Skaters MUST NOT enter the building if they are unable to answer NO to all of the covid screening questions - posted at the rink entrance and on the homepage of skatesaskatoon.com**
- 3. No extra family members are permitted in the building.**
- 4. A cloth or medical facemask MUST be worn by everyone who enters the building (lobby, dressing rooms, hallway). On the ice, the mask is OPTIONAL. Sanitize hands upon entry and exit of the building.**
- 5. The skater follows the arrows to dressing room #1 or dressing room #2. Please sit on a YELLOW "X" on the benches. When checked in by the coach, skaters are permitted to enter the ice area. Place guards at the mirror end of the ice by the pylons. Skate bags, shoes, etc can remain in the dressing room during the session.**
- 7. At the end of the session, follow the white arrows to the dressing room, take off skates, and exit out the back door of the arena.**

REMINDERS:

-No spectators; Washrooms in the dressing rooms are closed; Public washrooms are available in the east hallway.

-Helmets are highly recommended for those skaters that are unsure of their skating abilities.

-We will practice proper social distancing in the lobby, dressing rooms, and on the ice.
