A bridge from CanSkate into figure-skating development, combining small-group instruction with stronger technical foundations.

Program Details

- For skaters working on CanSkate Stages 4-6 interested in pursuing figure skating.
- Registration in this program requires a coach/coordinator recommendation to progress from Canskate into Junior Prep.

Weekly Package Sessions

- The package includes **2 instructed on-ice** and **1 off-ice** group classes for 11 weeks (33 sessions total). Select the package with the 2 on ice classes that best suit your schedule. The 3rd on ice can be added in separate registration if desired.
- Separate on ice group session registration is available if the package doesn't work for a skater. The package is recommended.
- The Junior Prep package skaters ALSO receive a 50% discount on registrations for options and ice drop-ins.

Equipment Required

- Figure skates are mandatory.
- CSA approved hockey helmets are mandatory for Stages 4-5. [Helmet Info Found Here.](#)
- Rubber or plastic skate guards.

Important Program Notes

- Parents/guardians or a designated supervising adult must remain at the facility during the lesson.
- Parents are not permitted in the ice area, off-ice room or music room unless authorized.
- All Off-ice classes will be held in the ACT Hall, located on the second floor of the ACT Figure Skating Arena. **Running shoes, water bottle, and athletic wear are required.**

Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1-August 30.
- Skaters must register only for sessions appropriate to their level.
- No pricing prorations.
- Program fees do not include taxes where applicable.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account **“Participant Profile”** by selecting and viewing **“Calendar”** tab. Verification of all option dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
