Coaches may move a skater to another suitable Free Skate session on the same day to accommodate lesson scheduling.

NOTE: THE RINK IS CLOSED AND THERE ARE NO SESSIONS ON THE FOLLOWING DATES:

- **Monday, OCTOBER 12 (Thanksgiving)**
- **Wednesday, NOVEMBER 11 (Remembrance Day)**

The session cost, program fees, and final session dates listed in the chart above already account for all scheduled rink closures.

Important Program Notes

- Parents are not permitted in the ice area, off-ice room or music room unless authorized.
- Mandatory \$15 +GST locker fee subscription. The effective period ends August 31, 2027. Email office@skatesaskatoon.com when locker is selected.

Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1, 2026-August 30, 2027.
- Skaters must register only for sessions appropriate to their level.
- No pricing prorations.
- Program fees do not include taxes where applicable.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
- **IMPORTANT: When your package includes a choice of sessions, you must still register for each session you plan to skate and they must be on the SAME invoice that you register for the package. Eligible sessions included in your package will show a fee of \$0.00 at registration.**
 - Registration is required so the club has an accurate record of who will be attending each session for administrative and safety purposes.
 - If a session does not show a fee of \$0.00, either:
 - The session is not one of the allowable selections; or
 - Your package registration has not yet been completed.
- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account **“Participant Profile”** by selecting and viewing **“Calendar”** tab. Verification of all option dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
