GENERAL INFORMATION

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the regulations as set forth in the Skate Canada Rule Book.

1. EVENTS

The following events are being offered as part of this competition:

Singles Free Skating	STAR 1 to Gold
Couples Pattern Dance	STAR 2/3 to Diamond
Solo Pattern Dance	STAR 2/3 to STAR 10/Gold
Artistic	STAR 5 to Gold
Element Events	STAR 2 to Gold

Special Olympics Singles Free Skate	Level 1 to Open
Special Olympics Solo Pattern Dance	Introductory to Level 6
Synchronized Skating	Beginner I, Beginner II and Elementary

Skaters may skate up one level.

Skaters registered in Pre-Novice or higher events at 2020 Sectionals (held in November 2019) may not compete at a Regional Invitational Competition <u>in the same discipline.</u> Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile single skaters are eligible to compete in an equivalent STAR event.

2. SYSTEM OF MARKING

Assessed to Standard and CPC Judging will be used for events. Assessed to Standard events will use Gold to Merit evaluations. Please refer to the Competition Program Requirements and applicable guide on the Skate Canada Info Centre for the complete details.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Schedule of events will be emailed if an address is provided. Otherwise, a schedule will be emailed to all clubs and coaches who have skaters in the competition as soon as possible after the closing of the entries.

4. ENTRIES

Entrants in events shall be:

- a. Eligible persons as defined in the Skate Canada Rule Book.
- b. Be Associate members in good standing of the Association.

Skaters entering multiple events do so with the understanding that there may be conflicts that <u>CANNOT</u> be resolved.

Registration forms **must be completed in FULL and CORRECTLY** or they will not be processed! Ensure the forms are reviewed for accuracy by the Coach and Parent **BEFORE** submitting them to the Host Committee.

Number of events entered per competitor may be limited at the discretion of the Technical Representative and the Host Committee. Competitors are restricted to enter three (3) single events.

5. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

All entries must be received no later than **December 22, 2019 at 11:59PM**. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date, at their own expense. **ALL TEST QUALIFICATIONS MUST BE PASSED BY THE CLOSING DATE OF THIS COMPETITION**.

6. ENTRY FEES

\$40.00 - Each event entered (excluding Team and Synchronized Skating events - see below)
\$40.00/team - Team
\$50.00/team - Synchronized Skating

We will only accept online payment by credit card at <u>www.skatesaskatoon.com</u>. Please create yourself a login using your email address and a password, then login and add your child as the participant. Go into the shopping to purchase a 'River Skate Ticket' for \$40.00 for each event you register into then print and include your ticket image with your registration forms. Synchronized Team Tickets are valued at \$50.00 per team. These can be screen-shots that are texted to 306-227-7500. Tickets will be taken off the website at precisely **11:59PM December 22, 2019**!

8. MUSIC REGISTRATION

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the performing rights societies.

Competitors, who have music composed specifically for their program either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from the performing rights societies.

For the information of Pattern Dance competitors: Skate Canada Series Eight music will be used for all pattern dance events. However, skater(s) have the option to use a selection from the ISU Ice Dance music (only tunes one to five) or from the Skate Canada approved list of contemporary music. If skater(s) choose to use either an ISU or contemporary music selection, they must supply this music to the competition organizers as indicated in the announcement for the competition. Only Skate Canada Series Eight music will be used during the warm-up period.

Music Requirements

- ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1 must submit an individual CD when they register at the competition.
- Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by category, program type (pattern dance, artistic, free skate) and music time shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case marked with the skater's name, category, program type and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk <u>at least 1.5 hours</u> prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage, but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rink-side during the skater's performance.

9. ACCIDENTS/LIABILITY

Skate Canada, the Saskatchewan Section, the host community and the volunteer team undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by skaters. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these events, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by or connected with, the conduct and management of the competitions and to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the association, the Section, the Skate Canada, the volunteer team and against their officers and their entries shall be accepted only on these conditions.

10. <u>REFUNDS</u>

Refunds will be issued for medical reasons only! Official notification must be given to registration in writing before the competitor's event is scheduled to occur. A medical certificate must be presented to the Host Committee for the refund. Medical certificates must be presented within 48 hours of the close of the event. A \$25.00 administration fee will be applied to all refunds. No refunds will be issued once a competitor has registered at the event.

11. REGISTRATION

Skaters must register at least 1.5 hours prior to their scheduled event. Music must be turned in at the time of registration. (2 copies of music must be registered with the backup CD to remain at rink side). Skaters must report to the Ice Captain 30 minutes prior to their scheduled event.

12. FLIGHT SYSTEM

If there are a large number of competitors in an event, a flight system may be used at the discretion of the Technical Representative. Skater's age and home club may determine flights.

13. EVENT SPECIFICATIONS

An event at the competition will be held if at least two (2) entries are received for that event. Where applicable, categories of an event may be combined to create an event.

The decision to combine events is at the discretion of the Technical Representative and the Host Committee. If an event is not held due to a lack of competitors, the Host Committee will inform competitors and return entry fees.

14. CANCELLATION OF EVENTS

The Host Committee in consultation with the Technical Representative reserves the right to cancel events.

15. COACH ACCREDITATION

Coaches must be a minimum of Regional Coach Certified and must meet the following accreditation standards:

a) Be a current professional coaching member of Skate Canada in good standing

Coaches must register in person.
