Winter Term 1 2026 | October - December

A small-group development program for talented young skaters ready to strengthen jumps, spins, footwork, artistry and confidence.

Program Details

- **CanSkate Stage 2-6. Age requirement: 7 years or younger as of July 1, 2026.**
- Designed for talented young skaters ready to develop their jumps, spins, footwork and artistry in a supportive small group environment.
- Small class sizes provide personalized instruction while building confidence, discipline, and teamwork.
- Coach recommendation and Director of Skating approval are required to register.
- Program includes: **2 instructed on-ice, 2 instructed off-ice** group classes, and **1 Freeskate on ice** session weekly. Semi-private lessons for instruction during the Free Skate session will be arranged separately for an additional fee. The Director of Skating will be in contact with you once your registration is finalized.
- You may purchase additional options or drop ins at a 50% discount. See *Options Brochure*.
- Off ice classes take place in the ACT hall, upstairs.

Equipment Required

- Figure skates and Rubber or plastic skate guards.
- CSA approved hockey helmets are mandatory for Stage 5 and below. [Helmet Info Found Here.](#)
- Runners and a water bottle for off ice classes.

Important Program Notes

- Parents/guardians or a designated supervising adult must remain at the facility during the lesson.
- Parents are not permitted in the ice area, off-ice room or music room unless authorized.
- All Off-ice classes will be held in the ACT Hall, located on the second floor of the ACT Figure Skating Arena. Running shoes, water bottle, and athletic wear are required.

Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1, 2026-August 30, 2027.
- Skaters must register only for sessions appropriate to their level.
- No pricing prorations.
- Program fees do not include taxes where applicable.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account **“Participant Profile”** by selecting and viewing **“Calendar”** tab. Verification of all option dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
