Pricing:

Each session is \$10 plus GST

With the purchase of a Sept 1 or 2 session(s), the 22-23 Skate Canada membership and 22-23 Skate Saskatchewan fee will be automatically added at checkout, unless the 22-23 Skate Canada membership is already in place through another club. Both memberships are in effect for one year – September 1 2022 – August 31 2023. The 22-23 Skate Canada membership is a cost of \$43.65 and the 22-23 Skate Saskatchewan fee is a cost of \$25.

With the purchase of an Aug 29-31 session(s), skaters are required to have the 21-22 Skate Canada and 21-22 Skate Saskatchewan memberships in place. If a skater doesn't have these in place they will be assigned automatically at checkout and are only in effect until August 31 2022.



All current Skate Canada members and Skate Canada registered coaches are welcome. Non-Skate Saskatoon coaches must get permission from Skate Saskatoon Executive if they had not requested permission for summer 2022. Email office@skatesaskatoon.com

Registration and Attendance Rules

1. No swapping or exchanging sessions
2. No make-up sessions
3. Private Group lessons – maximum of 2 skaters per coach
4. Skaters who have not yet passed Stage 3 of CanSkate are required to be in a lesson while on the ice (private or group)
 - a. Exception: Skaters registered in U7, or older hockey are eligible for All Levels sessions provided they are in a lesson (for the entire time they are on the ice), without having passed CanSkate STAGE 3
5. Pairs/Dance is permitted on sessions with fewer than 10 registered skaters (including the pair/dance team).
6. Skate Saskatoon reserves the right to modify or cancel programs or options at any time. Skate Saskatoon will provide as much cancellation notice as possible via email, the website and on social media. Please ensure your Uplifter account settings allow emails from Skate Saskatoon.
7. Skate Saskatoon is not required to provide makeup sessions or refunds for sessions missed as a result of unforeseen circumstances.
8. Skate Saskatoon reserves the right to revoke privileges of participants who do not follow guidelines or policies.
9. A Skate Canada Coach and/or Adult Spectator must be in the building for skater(s) to be on the ice. Skater(s) must exit the ice if none are present. No refunds or makeup sessions are provided.
10. No Earbuds or headphones are permitted on the ice (Exception: Skate Canada coaches using them to choreograph programs, NOTE: the coach can wear the earbud, NOT the skater).
11. Skaters must not enter the ice prior to the session start time and must exit the ice at the time the session ends.
12. 15-minute lesson ice tickets are not available for season transition ice.
