NEW REGISTRATION and ATTENDANCE RULES:

- 1. NO swapping of sessions for any reason, NO make-up sessions
- 2. **NO exchanging** sessions with another skater
- 3. Skating is only permitted on sessions that you are registered for in advance
- 4. NO ice session tickets are permitted in summer
- 5. NO 15 minute lesson ice tickets are permitted in summer
- 6. Session <u>lengths vary</u> Pricing is consistent on a per minute basis.
- 7. CanSkate and Advanced PreSTAR are unable to be offered this summer as per the Skate Canada Saskatchewan COVID-19 guidelines.

OPTIONS CAN BE PURCHASED: BY THE WEEK OR ON A SEASONAL BASIS ONLY

NOTE: A document outlining the additional restrictions and requirements due to COVID-19 will be made available prior to the start of Summer Skating.

KEY POINTS:

- 1. Skate Canada Saskatchewan Assumption of Risk Waiver must be at the Skate Canada Saskatchewan Office (Regina) prior to using the facility, these can be submitted by printing, filling out, taking a picture and email to Skate Saskatoon (office@skatesaskatoon.com) who will forward to Skate Canada Saskatchewan.
 - a. This waiver MUST be submitted 5 days prior to your first day of participation.
- 2. Skaters who are not on the Summer Coordinator's list will not be permitted to skate on that session, this is unlikely unless registration was completed only a few days prior to the skating session, and the office should be contacted, the Summer Coordinator cannot change registrations, this can only be completed by the office.
 - a. Registrations **MUST** be submitted 5 days prior to the start of the first session to allow for processing time.
- 3. Refunds will not be issued or credited for sessions missed due to incomplete paperwork or paperwork that was not submitted on time.
- 4. Refunds will only be issued due to COVID-19 related issues (personal or facility related) as assessed by the Board. No other refunds will be issued as per the existing Skate Saskatoon refund policy.
