

**SPRING 2021**  
**OPTION PROTOCOL**

1. If possible, arrive “rink ready” with skates and skate guards on.
  1. Dressing rooms are available for skaters that can tie their own skates, but those that need assistance must enter the facility with their skates on.
2. Skaters should read the screening questions thoroughly and **MUST NOT** enter the building if they answer YES to ANY of the Covid-19 screening questions.
3. Belongings brought into the rink should be kept to a minimum. Any belongings may be placed on the ground next to the pylon at the far end of the rink during the skating session.
4. Masks are required by all people in the building, at all times.
5. Use the main door as the entrance, and the east door as the exit (the same pathway as in winter). The arrows on the floor indicate how to proceed throughout the building.
6. Hands must be sanitized upon building entry and exit.
7. No spectators are permitted.
8. The building is not to be entered until 10 minutes prior to the skating session start time.
9. The washrooms in the change rooms are closed. No lockers are to be used.
10. Provincial guidelines regarding physical distancing must be followed by all parties at all times.
