**CanSkate - All skaters 3+ years of age are welcome. Skill and age groupings will be applied within the session. Classes accommodate Stages 1-6. Runs Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday in spring**

**Advanced PreStar/Star 1,2 - Stages 4 - 6 (figure skates) and skaters on Star 1 & 2. Runs Wednesday and Saturday in spring**

*The numbers listed behind the class name are only used to distinguish class times*

*As well as the two Advanced PreStar/Star 1, 2 group coached programs there are two practice sessions which include Star 3. The practice sessions are not coached*

*Assessments will not be done for Saturday classes due to the shorter number of sessions*

*Due to coach student ratios missed sessions cannot be made up*

**Power Skating - one class on Thursday night for up to 10 hockey players. Must be Novice or Atom**

## **Advanced PreStar and Star Spring Program**

Skaters must be able to skate and stop forwards and backwards and be over 5 years old. **It is recommended that skaters have completed CanSkate Stage 3 before joining the program.** Small groups are generally organized by age and ability. **Coaches will assist in placement.**

**Advanced PreStar and STAR** introduces skaters to skills in edges, stroking, freeskate, dance and performance and reinforces daily, proper warm up and practice technique. Confidence and ability to work independently at the Skate Canada Figure Skating level is another focus of the program.

## **ADDITIONAL SPRING OPTIONS AVAILABLE**

Some skaters require and prefer more skating time, individual instruction, or flexibility in the schedule. For these skaters, we provide the following options:

- 1. PRIVATE OR SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS** – Private and Semi Private lessons are available to all levels of skaters. These lessons are given on skating times organized by the coach and parent. Check with Skate Saskatoon coaches listed <http://www.skatesaskatoon.com> “Coaches” for availability and lesson rates. Up to 4 skaters can be included in a semi-private lesson.
- 2. ADDITIONAL SKATING TIMES** – In order to skate at any time outside of group lessons you must be registered for the option, have purchased a spring ice session ticket (or CanSkate tickets if you are registered in CanSkate) or be exchanging an unused session from another spring option of equal or lesser value that you are registered in. Skate Saskatoon offers skating times for all levels of skaters several times during the week. Sign in rules under policies on the website provide the related information and must be adhered to in order to enter the ice surface.
