**CanSkate - All children 3+ years of age are welcome. Skill and age groupings will be applied within the session. Classes accommodate Stages 1-6. Runs Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**

**Advanced PreSTAR/STAR 1, 2 – Stages 4 - 6 (figure skates) and skaters on STAR 1 & 2. Runs Wednesday and Saturday**

*The numbers listed behind the class name are only used to distinguish class times*

*As well as the two Advanced PreSTAR and STAR 1 & 2 group coached programs there are two practice sessions which include STAR 3. The practice sessions are not coached*

*In order to maintain coach student ratios missed sessions cannot be made up*

**Power Skating – Thursday nights (8:45 – 9:30 pm) for up to 8 hockey players. Must be Novice or Atom**

## **Advanced PreSTAR and STAR 1 & 2 Program**

Skaters must have completed CanSkate Stage 3 and have the coaches' recommendation before joining the Advanced PreSTAR program. Skaters must skate in figure skates.

Advanced PreSTAR and STAR introduces skaters to skills in edges, stroking, freeskate, dance and performance and reinforces daily, proper warm up and practice technique.

## **ADDITIONAL SPRING SKATING AVAILABLE**

1. **PRIVATE OR SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS** – Private and Semi Private lessons are available to all levels of skaters. These lessons are given on appropriate skating times organized by the coach and parent. Check with Skate Saskatoon coaches listed <http://www.skatesaskatoon.com> "Coaches" for availability and lesson rates. There is a maximum of 3 skaters per coach on STAR 1 – Gold and STAR 1 – 3 options and a maximum of 2 skaters per coach on all other options.
2. **REQUIREMENTS**
  - (a) In order to be on the ice surface without a coach the skater must be working on the levels designated in the option.
  - (b) In order to skate on an ice session, you must be registered for the option, have purchased a spring ice session ticket, be exchanging an unused session from another spring option that you are registered in or be in a private lesson using 15 minute lesson ice ticket(s). Sign-in procedures posted on the website provide the relevant information and must be adhered to in order to enter the ice surface.
  - (c) Ice Rules posted on the website must be followed at all times.
