SKATING CATEGORIES

CANSKATE - Stages 1 - 6

ADVANCED PRESTAR/STAR 1,2 - on Stages 4 - 6 (figure skates) and skaters on Star 1 & 2

POWER EDGES (non figure skates/hockey/ringette/speed interests) – Stages 4 – 6

INTERMEDIATE - on STAR 3, 4, 5 (according to Freeskate levels)

SENIOR - Competing Pre-Juvenile or Juvenile at Sectionals Nov. 2018. Passed STAR 5 Freeskate and up COMPETITVE - Competing Pre-Novice and up at Sectionals Nov. 2018

STROKING SESSIONS

Program focuses on dance steps, dance skills, dances, edges, turns, field movements, power, endurance, agility, flexibility, and stroking skills. Group coaching is provided.

DANCE AND PAIRS

Dance and Pairs teams ARE NOT ALLOWED ON OPTIONS WITH MORE THAN 14 SKATERS, for the safety of all

skaters. The 14 skaters include the dance/pair teams. On Pair/Dance/Open sessions - maximum 14 skaters.

Registered Skate Saskatoon teams and singles skaters have priority. Teams have right of way.

ICE SIGN IN RULES:

All Skaters must be registered or signed in to use the Ice Surface. Please refer to the **Sign- In Procedures** posted on the website under policies. All skaters must initial beside their registered name or fill in exchange details or a valid Ice Ticket Bar Code (provided by purchase of an ice session ticket) prior to using the ice surface.

Ice session tickets are purchased under products. There are two types of ice session tickets. CanSkate ice session tickets are **only** allowed when the skater is in a CanSkate program and is taking a private lesson with a coach. The coach must be noted on the sign in sheet. For further details re the CanSkate ice session tickets please refer to the CanSkate brochure.

If an Option session is missed, the skater may make up this time on another option within the current 2018 - 19 Winter Season and indicate the exchange in the Sign-in book. They must indicate the time missed, note the number of the session missed and the alternate session /time skated.

Maximum number of skaters allowed on Open Options is 24.

BEGINNER: FRIDAY SEPT 7 AND 14, 6:30-7:15 PM

ELEMENTARY/JUVENILE FRIDAY SEPT 7 AND 14, 7:15-8:00 PM

PRE-NOVICE: SUNDAY SEPT 9 AND 16, 6:30-7:15 PM

OPEN: SUNDAY SEPT 9 AND 16, 7:15-8:00 PM

MASTERS: THURSDAY SEPT 13 AND 20, 9:00- 9:45 PM

SKATE CANADA FEE MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO ATTENDING OPEN HOUSES

BEGINNER TEAM

This program is designed for skaters who are new to synchronized skating. Skaters must have CanSkate Stage 4 or equivalent. Registration fee includes ice and coaching expenses. Travel expenses, off-ice and costuming are extra. Skaters must not have reached the age of 12 by July 1st 2018.

ELEMENTARY/JUVENILE TEAM

This program is designed for skaters who are ready to move to the next level as their skating skills improve. Skaters must be in Advanced CanSkate level 6 to Junior (Pre-Preliminary) or equivalent. Registration fee includes ice and coaching expenses. Travel expenses, off-ice and costuming are extra. Skaters must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1, 2018.

PRE-NOVICE TEAM

Skaters must have Synchro skating experience or involvement in singles skating. Must have completed the Junior Program (Preliminary to Sr. Bronze). Registration fee includes ice time, off-ice and coaching. Travel and costuming are extra. The Full Membership fee is paid with registration. Skaters must have reached the age of 12 but must not have reached the age of 18 as of July 1, 2018.

OPEN TEAM

Skaters must have Synchro skating experience or involvement in singles skating. Must have completed the Junior Program (Preliminary to Sr. Bronze). Registration fee includes ice time, off-ice and coaching. Travel and costuming are extra. The Full Membership fee is paid with registration. Skaters must have reached the age of 15 as of July 1, 2018.

ADULT TEAM

Ideal for skaters who have been away from skating for a while and wish to start skating again. Ice fees include ice and coaching expenses. Travel expenses, off-ice and costuming are extra. No age limit.

* All teams are determined by the coach according to age and skill requirements*
