## SUMMER 2021 OPTION PROTOCOL EFFECTIVE JULY 13, 2021

- 1. Masking:
  - 1. Required by all parties (coaches, skaters, staff, spectators) in the lobby, dressing rooms, bathrooms and spectator area.
  - 2. Exception: **Participants** with full face masks or cages on their helmets who can proceed directly to the ice area (without waiting in the lobby or spectator area and without using a dressing room or bathroom) and will immediately leave the building at the end of their session with their skates and helmet on, are not required to wear a mask while moving through the lobby and exit hallway.
  - 3. Required by both skater and coach during harness lessons.
  - 4. Required in the coach's room except when consuming food or beverages.
  - 5. Required to be worn by the coach and skater if they need to make prolonged physical contact (i.e., partnered dance lessons).
  - 6. Not required by coaches or skaters while involved in skating activities (exceptions above).
- 2. Arrival and Departure:
  - 1. Skaters or spectators are expected NOT to enter the building if they are feeling unwell.
    - (a) The previously required health screening questionnaire is no longer required, however individuals should not enter the building if feeling unwell or have recently been in close contact with a known case of Covid-19 and are not fully vaccinated for Covid-19 (minimum of 14 days past the date of the second dose of a Covid-19 vaccine).
  - 2. Arrival is through the main doors and departure is through the "exit" door down the east hallway (follow the arrows on the floor).
  - 3. Arriving "rink ready" is recommended for skaters, and as only skaters (no guardians/parents) are permitted in the dressing rooms anyone requiring assistance with skate tying must arrive "rink ready" with skates on.
  - 4. Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and exit and its use is encouraged.
  - 5. Belongings brought into the rink should be kept to a minimum. Any belongings may be placed on the ground next to the pylon at the far end of the rink during the skating session.
  - 6. The building is not to be entered until 10 minutes prior to the skating session start time.
- 3. Spectators:
  - 1. Masks are required to be worn at all times by spectators.
  - 2. One spectator per active participant is permitted to watch from the spectator area (blue seats).
    - (a) When possible, an empty seat should be left between spectators to help maintain some physical distancing.
    - (b) Spectators are to remain seated during the session and <u>are not permitted in the</u> <u>dressing rooms.</u>
  - 3. No food or drink permitted in the spectator area (masks required at all times in this area.)
- 4. The washrooms in the change rooms are closed. No lockers are to be used.
- 5. When possible, physical distancing should be maintained by all parties.
