Registration Information

- **Skate Canada Membership:** All skaters must have an active Skate Canada membership in addition to the program fee. The mandatory annual membership fee of \$78.20 per registrant will be added at registration and is valid from September 1, 2026-August 30, 2027.

- Once registration is complete, all registered times can be located within your member account “**Participant Profile**” by selecting and viewing “**Calendar**” tab. Verification of all dates by checking your profile calendar is recommended.
- There is a \$30 + GST administration fee for any changes made to registered skating times after October 15, 2026.
